NOTES:

- * For planning purposes, CSFD requests 20-30 minutes per assessment, or no more than 12 assessments per four hour block assuming one CSFD Assessor. During two scheduled blocks (see above), CSFD can provide an additional Risk Assessor. Clearly, not all residents in a given area can be assessed in one blocked time slot. Additional Wildfire Risk Assessment blocks can be scheduled as necessary after all Areas have been visited the first time.
- * WMC Volunteers will “walk” each Area door-to-door approximately one week prior to the above Wildfire Risk Assessment assessment time blocks in order to schedule homeowners for their assessments. Volunteers will provide wildfire mitigation information materials to all residents contacted.
- * Also, homeowners may schedule individual Wildfire Risk Assessments with CSFD at their discretion, regardless of Area.
