Common Areas Landscape Master Plan

WHEREAS the Board of Directors (the "Board") of The University Park Homeowners Association, Inc. (UPHOA), a Colorado non-profit corporation (the "Association") has adopted this Charter providing for a new volunteer committee, which will be called the University Park Master Plan Committee.

Purpose:

- 1. to create a 5-year common areas landscape master plan that lets University Park residents work together on something positive, constructive and unifying
- 2. to get a preliminary budget for landscape improvements to be implemented over the next 5 years

NOTE: in addition to plant materials, landscape plans will consider maintenance and/or replacement of hardscape elements such as fences, walkways, irrigation, entrance features, lighting, benches and trash receptacles

Scope: create a Landscape Master Plan Committee of <u>no more than seven (7) people</u> to work with Gary Schmidt (UP HOA BOD and RLA) & Carla Anderson (RLA) on the following steps:

- 1. Site Visit(s)- document existing conditions, take photographs, discuss ideas for improvements
- 2. Brainstorming / Blue Sky Planning- as a group, develop ideas that may (or may not) be appropriate to improving the looks and function of our existing landscape (all ideas are okay, but not all ideas will be used)
- 3. Concept Designs using the most promising ideas from #2 above, develop conceptual landscape plans for up to nine areas within University Park in sufficient detail to be cost estimated
- 4. Preliminary Cost Estimating rough cut but sufficient to provide Treasurer with cost estimates for reserve study portion of the UPHOA budget
- 5. Board Presentation present plans to BOD and UP Community, prioritizing and ranking concept designs and signing off on next year's Final Design project(s) by September 30th

Timeframe: June through September 2025
